

What do I need?

- Print this on a cardstock.
- Get a "chess" piece or any small character piece that will represent the player.
- Make sure to prepare a dice for a random number pick.
- Invite a friend to play with. This can be played by 2-4 friends.

How to play?

- Each player will put their chess/character piece on box number 1. Each player will take turns in rolling the die.
- Move the chess/character piece depending on the count given by the die.
- If the piece lands at the bottom of a ladder the chess piece will move up.
- If the piece lands at the head of a snake the piece should move down.
- The first player to move on or beyond box 25 wins.

What does ladder and snakes stands for?

Ladder: These help players progress because they represent good digital safety practices

Box 5: Use a Strong Password

Ladder to Box 14 (Avoid sharing personal information publicly on social media)

Box 12: Don't log into your banking or important accounts over public Wi-F

Ladder to Box 21 (Use apps and tools that offer end-to-end encryption for messaging and online activities)

Box 15: Use Firewalls and Antivirus Software

Ladder to Box 17 (Check and limit the permissions you give to apps, especially those requesting access to your location or contacts)

Box 18: Download from Trusted Sources Only

Ladder to Box 23 (Check for unusual activity in your accounts and take action if you notice anything suspicious)

Snake: These represent poor digital safety habits and take players backward to earlier boxes.

Box 4: Avoid Suspicious Links

Snake down to Box 2 (Awareness of Online Risks): Clicking suspicious links sets you back because you may fall for phishing.

Box 13: Backup Your Data Regularly

Snake down to Box 6 (Set a passcode, PIN, or fingerprint to lock your devices)

Box 19: Log Out from Shared Devices

Snake down to Box 10 (Connect only to secure, password-protected networks, especially when handling sensitive information)

Box 24: Be Wary of Online Scams

Snake down to Box 1 (Understand Social Media Privacy Settings): Falling for scams puts your security at risk.
